Material:

100% cotton
Catania by Schachenmayr nomotta
Wight: Sport / 5 ply (12 wpi)

Colors:

208, 209, 222 ,114, 113, 219, 205, 165, 146
A hook – size 3

You could also use:
Camilla by Madame Tricote Paris

Used short-cuts:

Chain (CH)
Slip stitch (Sl St)
Single crochet (SC)
Double crochet (DC)
Half double crochet (HDC)

Let's beginJ :

1st Round: Chain 5 stitches and join it with slip stitch to form a ring.





2nd Round: Chain 3 (count as first DC), 1 DC in ring, (1 chain stitch, 2 DC in ring) 5 times, 1 chain stitch, join with slip stitch to first DC (6 shells).



3rd Round: Join next color and crochet in each of the 6 chain spaces: (2 DC, 1 CH, 2 DC, 1CH). Join with SI St to first DC.





4th Round: crochet 7 DC in each of the 5 chain spaces. Join with slip stitch to first DC



5th Round: Join next color and crochet 1 SC in each of the next 7 DC, except between the 2 DC of the third row where you do a Sl St which you join to the 3rd round in order to form the petal - (7 SC and 1 Sl St) 6 times.



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6th Round: Join next color and crochet 1 SC in each SC, except for the middle of each petal where you crochet 2 SC in one stitch in each petal. Tie off.





7th Round: Yellow - *2 DC, 1CH, leave 2 stitches, 2 DC, 1CH, leave 2 stitches, (2 DC, 1CH, 2DC) – in one stitch * – from * to * repeat to the end of round, join by SI St

8th Round: 3 CH as a 1st DC, 1DC, 1CH, *2DC in the loop, 1CH *- repeat to the end, join with 1st DC by SI St



9th Round: Orange - 3 CH as a 1st DC, 2DC, 1CH, *3DC in the loop, 1CH *- repeat to the end, join with 1st DC by SI St

10th Round: same as 9th Round





- 11th Round: *cyclamen* - 5 CH, 1 SI St in a loop – all round
12th Round: 5 CH, 1 SI St in the 5 CH loop from previous round – repeat all round
13th and 14th Rounds – repeat 12th Round



- 15th, 16th Rounds – repeat 9th Round, but work with *Violet*





17th, 18th Rounds – repeat 9th Round, but work with Rose



19th Round: *apple* - 5 CH, 1 SI St in a loop – all round

20th Round: 5 CH, 1 SI St in the 5 CH loop from previous round – repeat all round

21st and 22nd Rounds – repeat 19th Round





23rd Round: *turquoise* - 3 HDC loop, 3 HCD in a loop, 2 HDC in a loop – repeat to the end of round. Join with SI St

24th Round: SC all round, join with SI St

25th Round: 1 SI St, leave 1 stitch, *5 SC in one stitch, leave 1 stitch, 1 SI St, leave 1 stitch* - repeat to the end of round, Join with SI St. End work.



Now make the strap

Make chain – I made about 83 cm (33 inches) long chain (*Rose*)

Then do SC all line (*cyclamen*)

Make 1 SI St, *CH 3, leave one stitch, 1 SI St* – repeat to the end (*water blue*)

Finishing:

Cut free threads, sew the strap on the purse. Add the beads to ribbon (ribbon was made from chains). You have finishedJ
